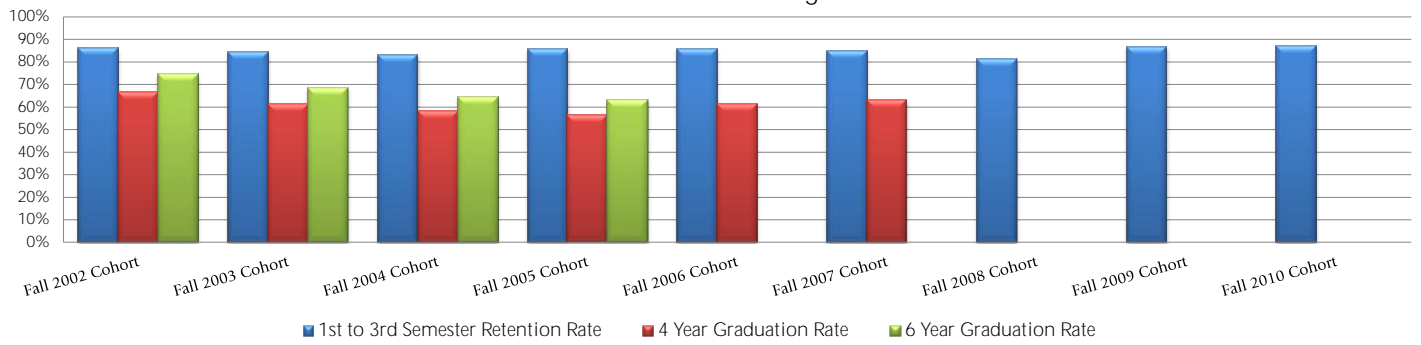


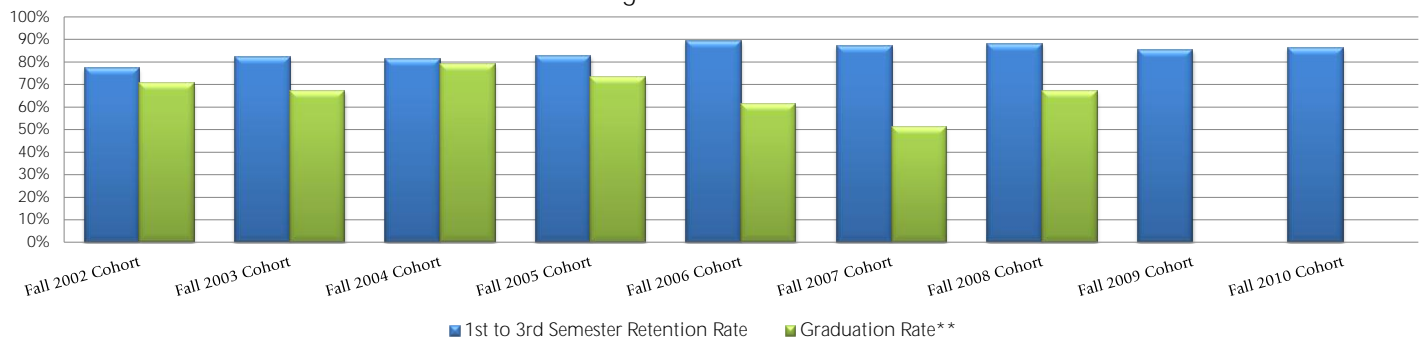

College of Arts & Sciences Retention & Graduation Rates First-Time Full-Time Entering Freshmen



The First-Time Full-Time Entering Freshmen 1st to 3rd Semester Retention Rate is the number of entering fall first-time full-time freshmen who return to the College of Arts & Sciences the next fall. The 4 year and 6 year graduation rates are the number of these fall students who graduate from the College of Arts & Sciences in 4 and 6 years. This number does not include those students who start as freshmen at the University of Redlands' College of Arts & Sciences but transfer and graduate from another college or university.

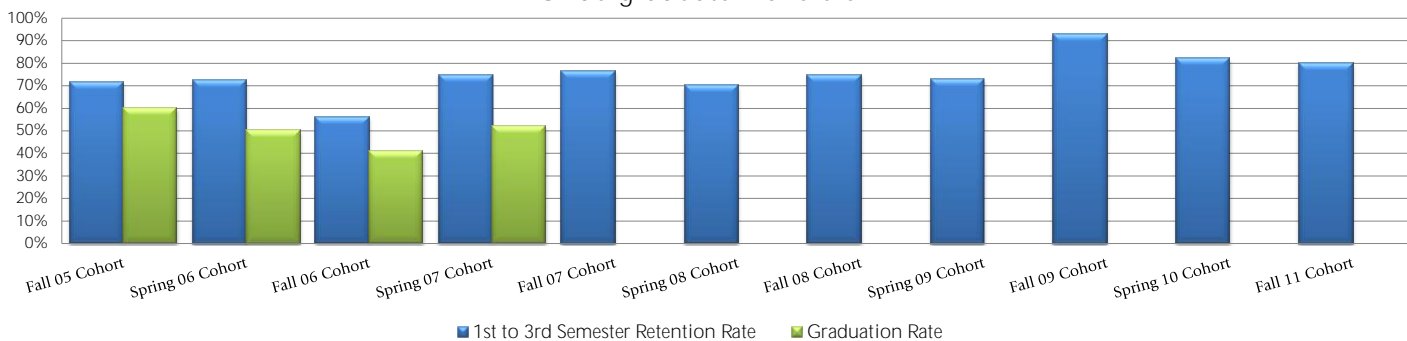
College of Arts & Sciences Retention & Graduation Rates Undergraduate Transfers



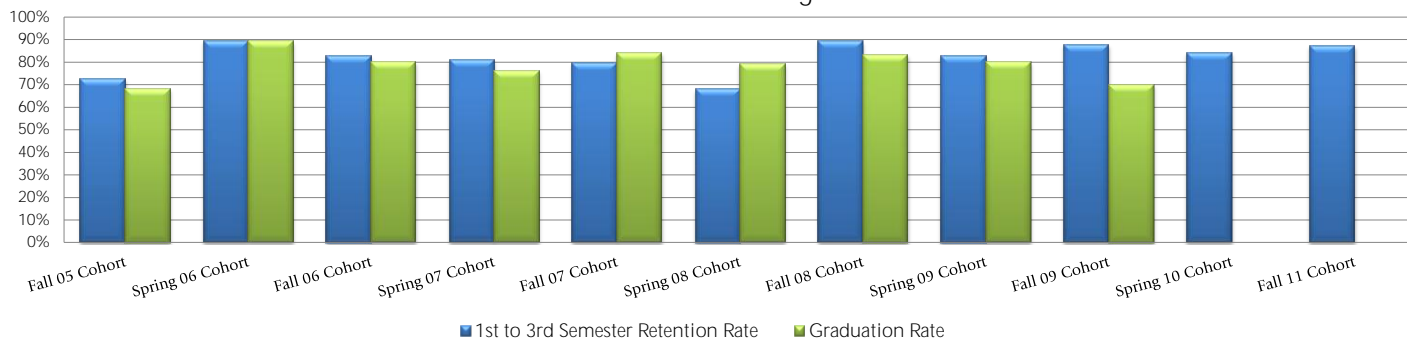

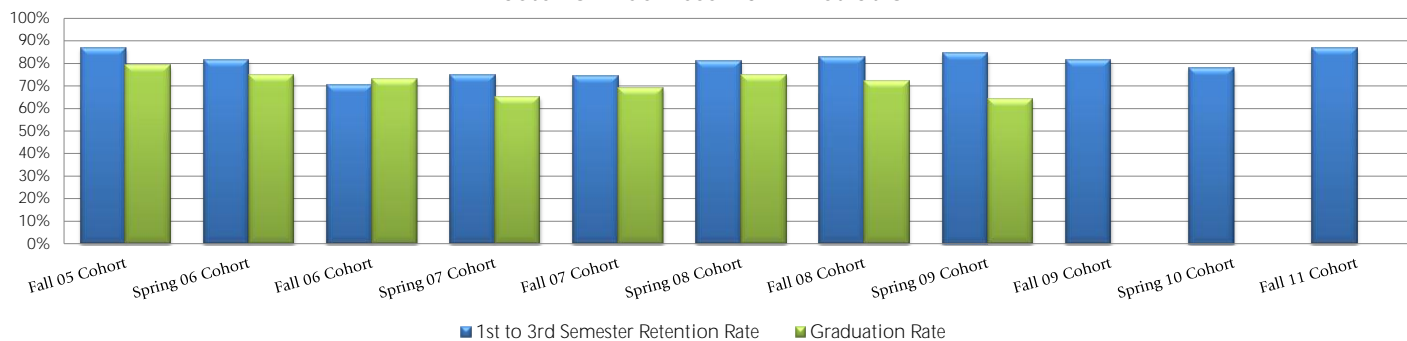
School of Business Retention & Graduation Rates

Master of Arts in Management



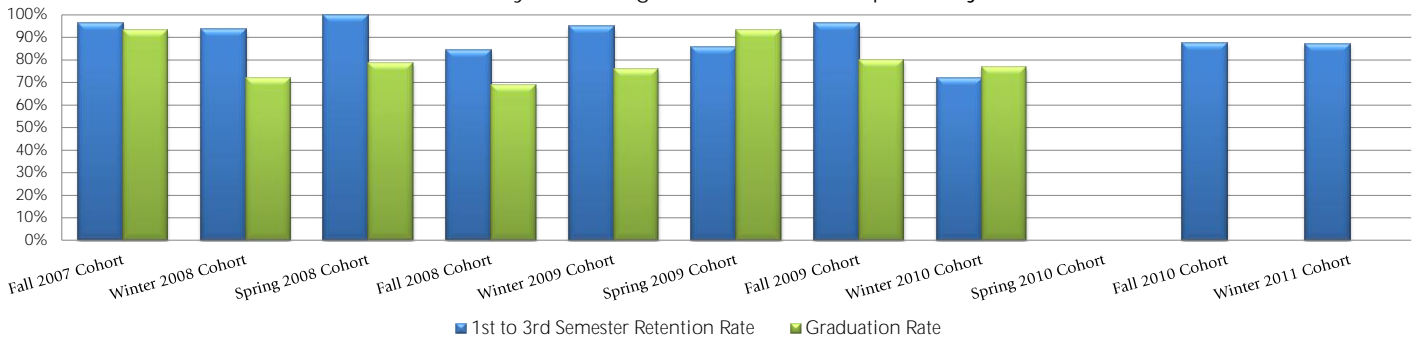

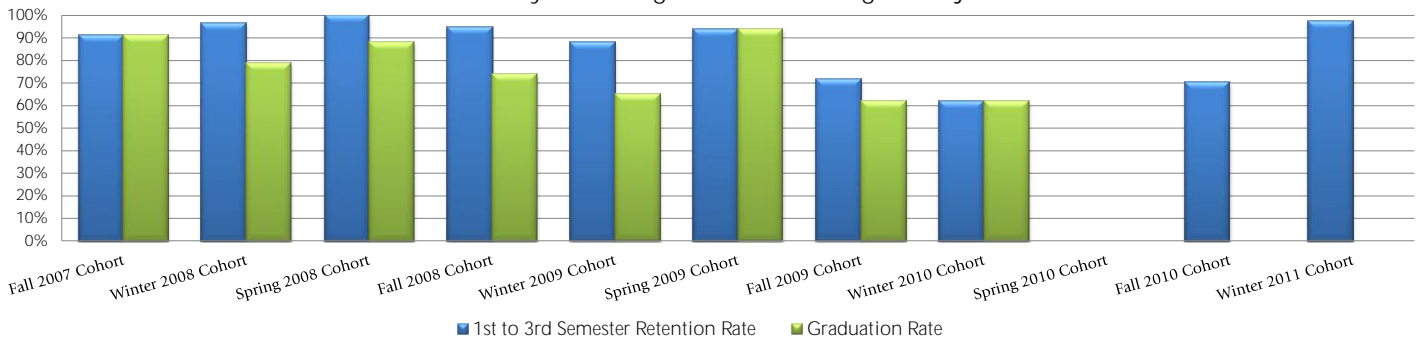
