CULMINATING EXPERIENCES AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Fieldwork

Students in the program must complete 400 of their required 600 hours in two different K-12 settings, one must be a High School (California state requirement for the PPS Credential). The remaining 200 hours of practicum must be completed in a college setting. Student will work with their advisor to identify fieldwork placement site.

Application for Graduation

Students who have completed all program requirements should contact the Fieldwork and Advising Office to request a degree sign off and a credential recommendation.

Commencement

School of Education students complete program requirements at various points throughout the year. Students may apply to commence in the academic year in which they complete their program requirements as long as they do so by August 31. An application must include a reasonable plan for completing the remaining credits by August 31 and should be submitted to the student's advisor by January 31.
