- ☐ Artifacts that demonstrate mastery of the standards have been carefully selected
- ☐ Artifacts are labeled to show what standard/ sub-standard(s) they master (1.0, 1.2, 1.4, 2.3, etc.)
- ☐ The sub-standard mastery form demonstrates mastery of each sub-standard with a mix of artifacts, class assignments, reflection on a class activity or reflections on reading.
 - Relevant artifacts and assignments are enclosed and labeled
 - The form refers to the artifact/assignment identification numbers
 - The form clearly specify how the sub-standard was mastered
