

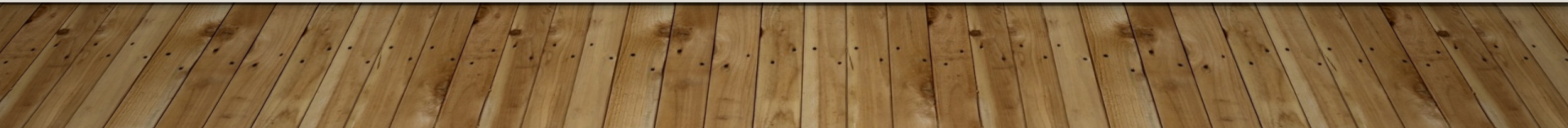

# SUMMER 2021

- **MALT students**
  - Will take master research course: **MALT 610**
- **EDUC students**
  - Will take a **Leave of Absence (LOA)** from the university and return in the Fall to student teach/intern
    - Reach out to **Advisor** at the end of **Spring 2021** term to discuss policy, form and expectations while on leave
- **Online EDSP students**
  - Will take **EDSP 610** and **MALT 601**

# SPRING 2021 AND BEYOND: PLANNING AHEAD

## Student Teaching/Internship

- Fall 2021 Student Teaching application
  - Application due May 14, 2021 [Application Link](#)
  - Important documents to submit:
    - Subject Matter Competency (i.e. CSET exams)
    - Negative TB test
      - Must cover entire program (cannot expire before or during student teaching term) – until at least February 2022
    - CPR certification
- Fall 2021 Fall
  - Evidence of U.S. Constitution, 4 Letters of Recommendation (2 outside/2 UoR), Essay, Resume.



# STUDENT TEACHING VS. INTERNSHIP

## Student Teaching

- OSS places students
- 14 weeks in the classroom
- Guest in classroom; assigned to Cooperating Teacher
- Best route for students who don't have a lot of experience in the classroom yet.

## Internship

- Approved students become intern-eligible and receives letter of eligibility
- Students must find their own internship (be hired by a district)
- Issued Intern Credential
- 14 weeks of being overseen by the UoR
- Paid position
- Good route for students with prior teaching experience and confidence.
