FIELDWORK OPTIONS

STUDENT TEACHING

- OSS places students
- 14 weeks in the classroom
- Guest in classroom; assigned to a Cooperating Teacher
- Lots of time to observe teaching styles
- Receive daily support
- Best route for students who don't have a lot of experience in the classroom yet.

INTERNSHIP

- Approved students become intern-eligible & receives letter of eligibility
- Students must find their own internship at a public school district or public charter school
- Recommended for Intern Credential
- 14 weeks of being overseen by the UoR
- Paid position with benefits
- Good route for students with prior teaching experience and confidence.
